
#### THE MABGA RING

When a preferred lie is needed, the MABGA\* Ring is utilized to improve lie within a restricted area of a six inch diameter with no advantage given to stance position.

\* Middle Atlantic Blind Golfers Association

The Mabga Ring was initiated at Edgmont Golf Club during the last Fifth MABGA Open in 1966 (won by Bill Collins).

This ring was also used by 107 P.G.A. Golf Professionals and highly accepted.
