Renovation Update

The weather conditions did not allow for much work on the paths over the winter. The cart paths on 10-18 and 1 through 4 tee are complete. The paths on 4-9 are at various stages of replacement. The paths should be completed by the end of April.

Approximately 209 yardage markers were added to the sprinkler heads on the course. (See section on yardage marking system)

- 6) In the event there is more than one sponsoring member the credit will be split.
- 7) Initiation fee and dues for the new member must be paid prior to June 21, 2006.

Yardage Marketing System at Edgmont Country Club

Two hundred nine (209) yardage markers were added to the sprinkler heads on the course and the practice facility. The following guidelines will help you determine your distance to the green.

- 1) The yardage on the fairway markers are to the center of the green.
- 2) The yardage on the tee markers on the par 3s are front edge, middle & back edge.
- 3) The sprinkler heads on the par 4s are marked between approximately 50-200 yards
- 4) The sprinkler heads on the par 5s are marked between approximately 50-250 yards
- 5) The distance between the fairway sprinkler heads is approximately 25 yards.
- 6) All distance are straight line measurements and do not account for elevation changes.
- 7) All distances were determined by using GPS data.
